What is Cetyl Myristoleate and how did it come about?

» The late Harry Diehl, a former research chemist at NIH, discovered Cetyl Myristoleate (CMO). He discovered that he was unable to create Freund's adjuvant-induced arthritis in Swiss albino mice. He subsequently isolated CMO from these mice and was able to protect a susceptible species of rat from adjuvant arthritis by pretreating them, using the CMO he isolated from the mice. Diehl was unable to generate much interest in his findings, and the information went largely untapped for 30 years. He was eventually awarded three patents for the use of CMO in connection with several forms of joint health problems. How does it work?

» Cetyl Myristoleate (CMO) works quite different from joint-rebuilding nutrients. CMO has been clinically observed to function in at least **four different ways**. It has been found to work as a **lubricant** (**sometimes referred to as nature's WD-40**), a **painkiller**, an **anti-inflammatory**, and, what may be very important, an **immune system modulator**. Although the exact mechanisms are not known at this time, there are some very strong indications that CMO, a fatty acid ester, is incorporated into the lipid layers of cell membranes. One theory is that if the method by which immune cells communicate is altered by reprogramming cell membrane receptor sites, these fatty acid esters could redirect a misdirected immune response. Another theory is that this group of fatty acid esters reprograms immune cells that have lived long beyond their normal life span. All cells in the body are programmed to die within a certain range of time. This preprogrammed cell death is called *apoptosis*. If this program has been modified in any way, these immune cells can **produce damage** and anything that would help to reprogram apoptosis would have benefits in joint health.

Dogs over 25 lbs:

Loading Dose: 1 pill for every 25 lbs for 60 days. Maintenance Dose: 1/2 pill for every 25 lbs.
